# NATIONAL ANTI- NARCOTICS AGENCY (NANA)

- NANA was established in July, 2017 and became operationalized in October, 2017.
- NANA serves as the national coordinating agency for counter drug operations both in the domestic and international fields.
- Oversight responsibilities rest with the Strategic Oversight Council, chaired by our President
- The agency reports directly to the Ministry of Public Security
- It is tasked with developing and implementing evidence based drug policies and programs in collaboration with all national stakeholders
