ANNEX I: CONTENT OF WORKSHOPS

WORKSHOP A. LEGISLATION

Chairperson: Carmen Ballester - Special Anti-Drug Attorney of the National Court, Spain.

Topics:

- Administrative, criminal and procedural legislation.
- Scope of the implementation of legislation with regards to non-controlled substances, precursors, and new psychoactive substances (NPS).
- Challenge of the *Darknet* for competent authorities to tackle the buying and selling of new chemical precursors and NPS, as well as the payment with virtual currency.

WORKSHOP B. LAW ENFORCEMENT TECHNICAL VISUAL INSPECTION, SEIZURES

Chairperson: Verónica España - Area Director, National Center for Planning, Analysis and Information on Organized Crime, Mexico.

Topics:

- Law enforcement technical visual inspection.
